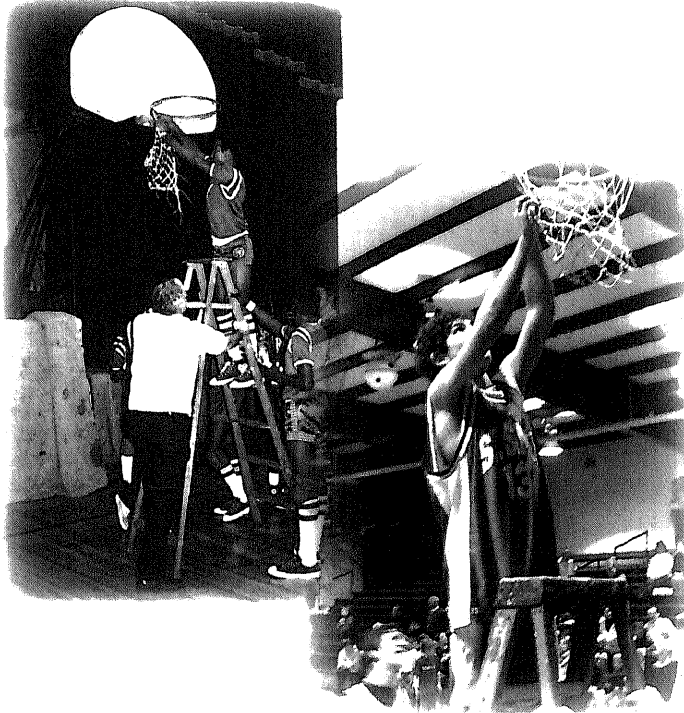
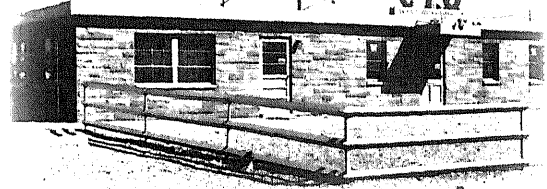
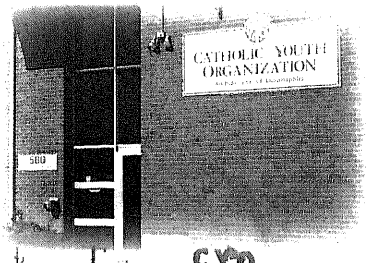

2005-2006 Annual Report and Year End Review



The Catholic Youth Organization was established in 1939 by Bishop Joseph E. Ritter to assist parents in providing quality educational programs for children as well as to supplement the education provided by the Catholic schools.



The first official activity sponsored by the CYO was a city-wide spring dance in the Cathedral High School gymnasium with about 1,000 youth in attendance, representing every parish in the city. The first athletic leagues organized were baseball and tennis with steps taken in the early days of the CYO to organize other contests and competitions.

Since this humble beginning, the CYO has grown into one of the largest youth serving agencies in Central Indiana serving over 20,000 young people each year.



In partnership with the Catholic schools, the CYO continues to sponsor programs which serve to provide opportunities for youth to develop strong moral character, self worth and a community service orientation through activities of a social, educational, recreational, and athletic nature.

The CYO is the sole provider of extracurricular activities for the Catholic schools in the Indianapolis metropolitan area. As such, it is the desire of the CYO to allow children the opportunity to experience real life situations that reinforce attitudes and values taught in school. In addition to providing athletic competition in 14 different sports for boys and girls in grades four through 12, the CYO also sponsors a science fair, music contest, honors music recital and a chess league.



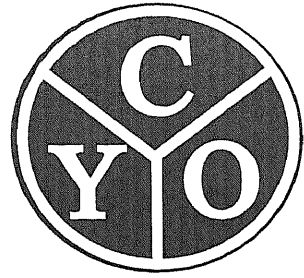
In 1947, the CYO opened a summer residential camp in Brown County, Indiana on land given to the CYO by Mr. and Mrs. Bert Dingley the previous year.

Over time, Camp Rancho Framasa has grown into a facility offering year-round camping opportunities and an inclusive outdoor education program.

The camp has recently undergone an extensive redevelopment plan including the construction of a dining hall/outdoor program center, three new cabins, the remodeling of all existing cabins and the refurbishing of the camp swimming pool. The facility has been improved to meet the needs of campers well into the 21st century.

The Catholic Youth Organization has been evolving for many years to what it is today. The CYO continues to be committed to providing a ministry of information that helps bring youth to their full human potential.

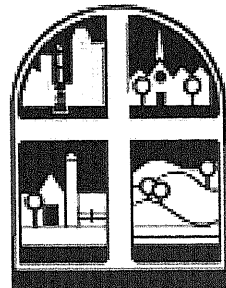

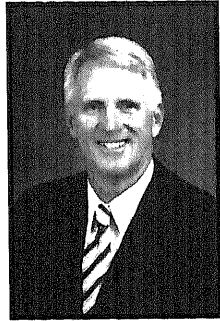

The Sahm - Kuntz Legacy Fund was established in 2006 as a way for the CYO to join forces with corporate partners in the community in an attempt to bring people from diverse backgrounds together to inspire and educate young people about the qualities and characteristics that drive them to become self-confident leaders and loving and caring individuals.

CYO Corporate Partners make an annual gift to the Catholic Youth Organization in the amount of \$1,500. Half of the gift or \$750 is used for yearly operating expenses and the other 50% is placed in an endowment to support the future needs of the organization. A corporate partnership with the CYO clearly supports the youth of today and tomorrow in a meaningful way.

The Catholic Youth Organization was established in 1939 by Bishop Joseph E. It is truly fitting that the CYO corporate partnership program is named the Sahm - Kuntz Legacy Fund after these two fine gentlemen. The collective impact of their service is deeply felt yesterday, today and tomorrow.

A Celebration of 60 Years of Catholic Camping

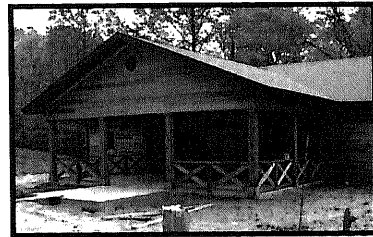
In 1946 Mr. and Mrs. Bert Dingley gave the Catholic Youth Organization 280 acres of land in Brown County, Indiana for the purpose of establishing a Catholic camping facility for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The camp was named Rancho Framasa after the Dingley's three daughters, **Frances**, **Martha** and **Samuella**. Thus, in 1947 the CYO summer camping program, a program that has meant so much to the youth of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, began.



Outdoor Education Center -  
Dining Facility

Over the years since 1946, CYO Camp Rancho Framasa has evolved and in addition to the inclusive summer camping program the facility now offers year-round camping programs which includes outdoor education for students K - 8th grades, leadership programs for students 7 - 12th grades and retreat programs for various age groups.

Since 1993, the facility at Camp Rancho Framasa has been undergoing a complete face lift with the construction of an outdoor program center complete with a new dining hall and meeting rooms, at a cost of \$1,600,000 as the centerpiece of the facility. Three beautiful new cabins have been built and all existing cabins have been renovated. The camp swimming pool has also recently been renovated. The grand total of money spent on camp upgrades, renovations and new camp buildings since 1993 is \$3,276,000.



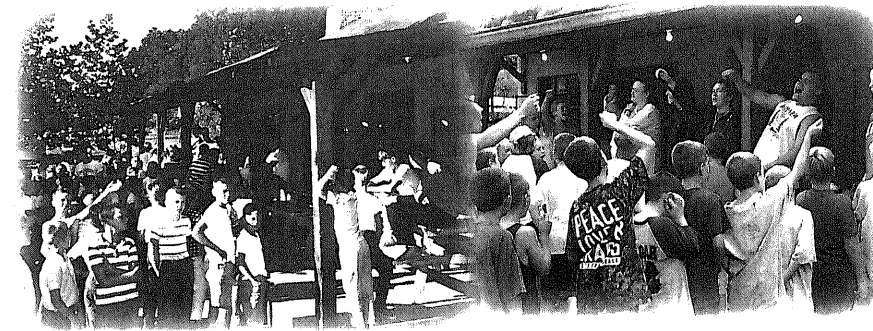
Recently Constructed Cabin

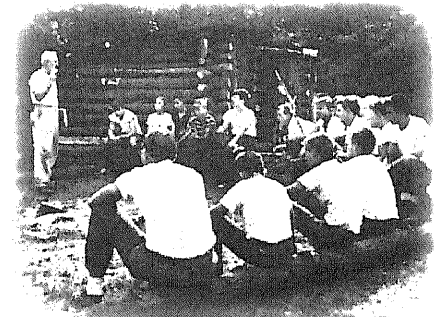

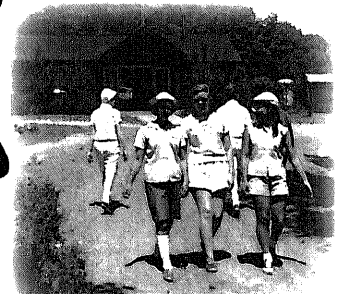

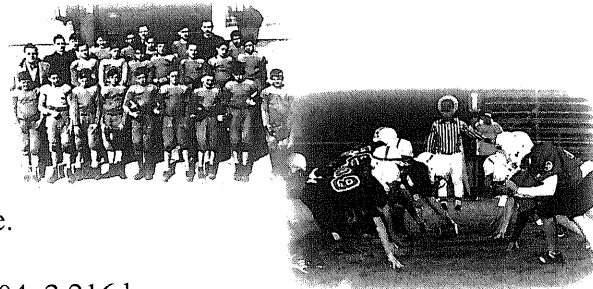

## 2005 CYO Fall Activities

### Football

- In 2005 a postseason tournament was added to all CYO football leagues allowing all teams to participate in a year - end tournament. Previously, only division champions in each league played in the league playoffs. The leagues were also divided in half based on school size to make the tournaments smaller in size. The football leagues were as follows: 3rd Grade A and AA, 34A and AA, 4th Grade A and AA, 5th Grade, 56A and AA, and Cadet A and AA.
- 49 teams and 873 players participated in the 34 football league.
- 40 teams and 847 players participated in the 56 football league.
- 27 teams and 600 players participated in the Cadet football league.
- 2,329 total boys played CYO football on 116 parish teams. In 2004, 2,216 boys played on 110 parish teams.
- The CYO football championship games were played at Roncalli High School Stadium.



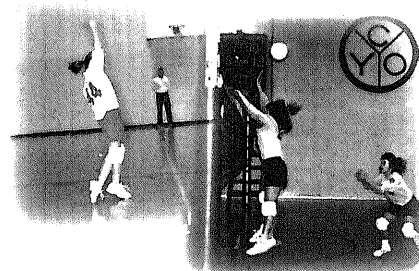
### Fall Kickball



- 163 teams participated in five different leagues in grades four through eight. By comparison, 165 parish teams participated in the fall of 2004.
- Competition was conducted in 4th grade, 56B, 56A, Cadet B, and Cadet A leagues. There were no C league teams this season.
- With almost 2,000 girls participating in the CYO Fall Kickball Program, the sport continues to be one of the most popular and traditional activities on the CYO calendar.

### Girls High School Volleyball

- The ninth season for the Girls High School Volleyball Program was successful and enjoyable for the 200 girls that participated.
- 19 teams were entered into the program this Fall with games being played on Sunday afternoons.
- The postseason tournament was played at the CYO Center Gymnasium on October 2, 2005.

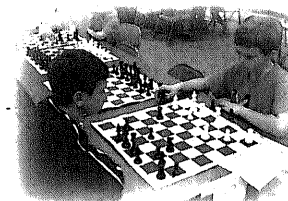
### Cross Country

- 16 teams participated in the eighth season of CYO Cross Country.
- The program is offered to boys and girls in grades five through eight with almost 500 youth participating.
- The season consisted of four regular season meets and a city-wide championship meet.
- The CYO city cross country meet was again held at Southeast Way Park.



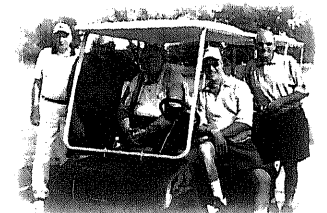
### Chess

- This was the eighth season for the CYO Chess Program for the Catholic schools.
- This year 8 parishes entered 34 teams into the program with 136 youth participating. Last year 7 parishes entered 29 teams into the program.
- Competition was divided into these separate age groups: 3rd Grade and under, 6th Grade and under and 8th Grade and under.
- The league featured academic competition among schools and was based on team play with each team consisting of four players.
- The program featured five weeks of competition and a postseason tournament held at the CYO Center Gymnasium.



### Golf Outing

- The 12th Annual CYO Golf Outing was held Thursday, September 8, 2005 at the Links Golf Club in New Palestine.
- The outing featured 92 golfers playing in 23 foursomes.
- Almost 100 hole sponsors supported the event that raised almost \$10,000 for the CYO.

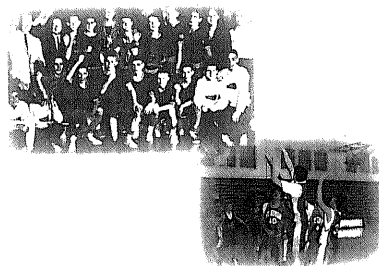

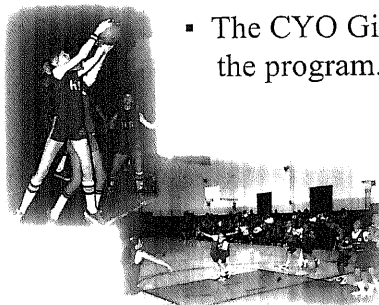
### Boys Basketball

- 452 basketball teams were entered into the 2005-2006 Boys Basketball Program up from 438 teams in 2004 - 2005.
- Over 3,700 boys and 900 coaches participated in the program.
- Competition was held in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 56C, 56B, 56A, Cadet C, Cadet B, Cadet A, Freshmen – Sophomore, Junior – Senior and Girls High School leagues.
- The Grade School Archdiocesan Championship Game was played at Seccina Memorial High School on February 19, 2006.



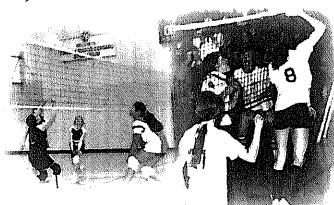
### Girls Basketball

- The CYO Girls Basketball Program continued to be strong in 2005 with 227 teams entered into the program. In 2004, 225 teams participated.
- Competition was conducted in 4th Grade, 56C, 56B, 56A, Cadet C, Cadet B, and Cadet A leagues.
- Over 2,000 girls participated in The CYO Girls Program.



### Girls Volleyball

- The Girls Volleyball Program continued to thrive with 295 teams entered into the program in 2006.
- Competition was conducted in 4th grade, 56C, 56B, 56A, Cadet C, Cadet B and Cadet A leagues.
- Over 2,700 girls participated in the program.



### Wrestling

- The Boys Wrestling Program continued to be steady with 17 teams entered in the 2006 season. 17 teams also participated in 2005.
- 371 boys participated in the 2006 Wrestling Program.
- Competition was held in 18 different weight classes beginning with 65 pounds and continuing up to 275 pounds.



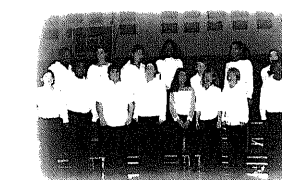

## 2006 CYO Winter Activities

- The regular season consisted of seven matches and an invitational tournament for each team.
- The season – ending city tournament was hosted by Cardinal Ritter High School where 18 individual weight class winners were determined.



### Music Contest



- The 48<sup>th</sup> Annual CYO Archdiocesan Music Contest was held at Bishop Chatard High School for the 32<sup>nd</sup> consecutive year. Almost 800 students from throughout the Archdiocese participated in this one day event.
- The CYO Music Contest is the only competition in the area other than the Indiana State Music Association Contest. Many students were entered into the contest through private music teachers and public schools with 25% of the students coming from outside the Catholic school system.
- Competition was held in piano, vocal and instrumental divisions.
- The most outstanding participants from the contest participated in an honors music recital at Cathedral High School one week after the contest.



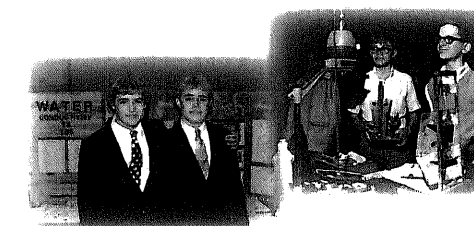
### Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament

- 12 high school co-ed volleyball teams were entered into the 2006 Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament.
- Over 120 high school boys and girls participated in the tournament held at the St. Roch Gymnasium.
- This double-elimination tournament featured rally scoring and free substitution to keep the event fast paced and enjoyable.



### Science Fair

- 17 schools and 135 students from throughout the Indianapolis Archdiocese participated in the 2006 CYO Science Fair held at the CYO Center Gymnasium.
- Participants in the science fair were winners from the many school science fairs held in schools in the Archdiocese.
- Students exhibited projects in the physical and biological science divisions.
- Awards were presented to the outstanding presenters in the 7th and 8th grades.



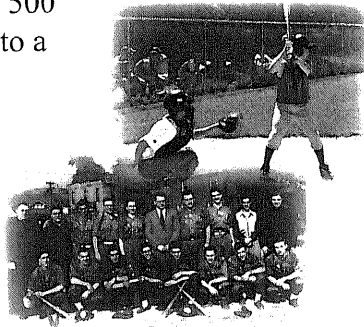

## 2006 CYO Spring Activities

### Baseball

- 39 baseball teams were entered into the 2006 CYO Baseball Program and over 500 boys participated. Of the 39 teams entered, 12 were 7<sup>th</sup> grade teams entered into a 7<sup>th</sup> grade league.
- The weather during the spring was fairly dry allowing the baseball program to be completed before the end of the school year.
- The 7<sup>th</sup> grade championship game was played at Msgr. Downey Field and the Cadet championship game was played at Bishop Chatard High School.



### Spring Kickball

- 68 teams participated in the 2006 Spring Kickball Program.
- Fewer teams participate in the Spring kickball program compared to the Fall Program due to the increased number of activities in the Spring for the girls.
- Over 700 girls played kickball in the 2006 CYO Spring Kickball Program.



### Soccer

- 55 teams were entered into the 2006 CYO Soccer Program – 26 Cadet level teams and 29 56 level teams.
- The CYO Soccer Program is co-ed for both leagues with over 1,000 boys and girls participating.
- The soccer league championship games were played at the St. Matthew Soccer Field.



### Girls Softball

- The Girls Softball Program had 11 teams participate in 2006, down from 13 teams in 2005 and 16 teams in 2004. This was the fourth season for CYO softball and 150 girls participated.
- The season consisted of eight regular season games, concluding with the league playoffs for the division champions.
- It is anticipated that the CYO Softball Program will grow slightly in the coming years. Conflicts with other softball leagues and a shortage of fields and umpires could prevent this program from growing.

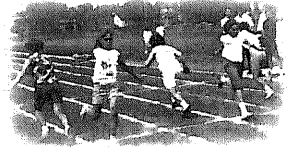
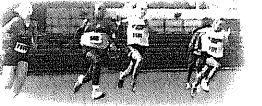

### Track

- 31 teams participated in the 2006 CYO Track Program, up from 28 in 2005.
- Over 1,100 boys and girls participated in the CYO Track Program.
- Track participants were divided into 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 56, Cadet leagues. Team members compete in both field and running events.
- The CYO City Track Meet was again held at the Michael A. Carroll Track and Field Stadium on the campus of IUPUI.

- The CYO Spring Bingo Night fund-raiser was held Saturday, March 11, 2006 at the Central Catholic Gymnasium.
- The event was well attended with nearly 500 people participating.
- The evening featured dinner, bingo, and many cash and prize giveaways.

- The Spring Bingo fund-raiser was chaired by Tom McNulty and Karen Corsaro and raised \$15,000 for the CYO.



### Volunteer Awards Ceremony

- The 2005 CYO Volunteer Awards Ceremony was held Wednesday, May 10, 2005 at SS. Peter and Paul Cathedral.
- Monsignor Joseph F. Schaedel, Vicar General of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, presided at the ceremony.
- The ceremony featured the presentation of the Spirit of Youth Awards, Monsignor Albert Busald Awards and the St. John Bosco Medals.
- Spirit of Youth Awards were presented to 30 high school age youth for service to their parish and community.
- Monsignor Albert Busald Awards were presented to 29 adult volunteers.
- St. John Bosco Medals were presented to 6 adult volunteers for their long term service to youth.

- 191 tickets were sold to the raffle which raised over \$20,000 for the CYO.

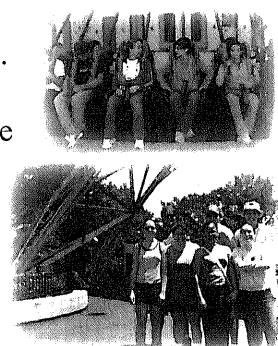
### CYO Archdiocesan Kings Island Day

- For the past 26 years the CYO has sponsored the Archdiocesan - Wide Kings Island Family Day.



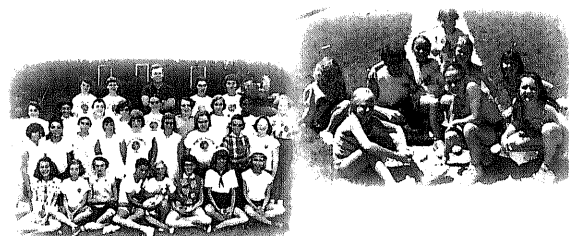
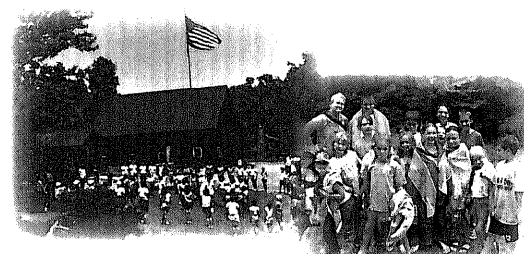
- In 2006 almost 1,000 youth and adults participated in this annual event.

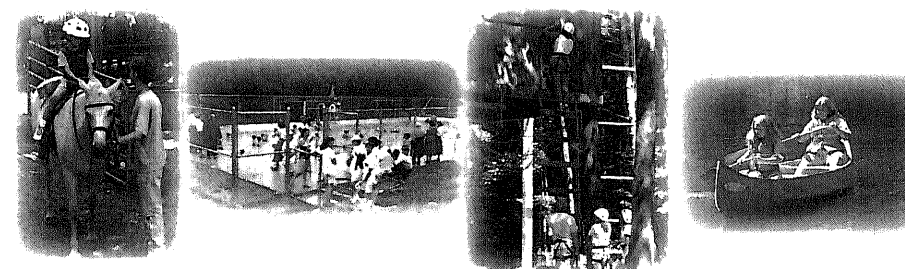

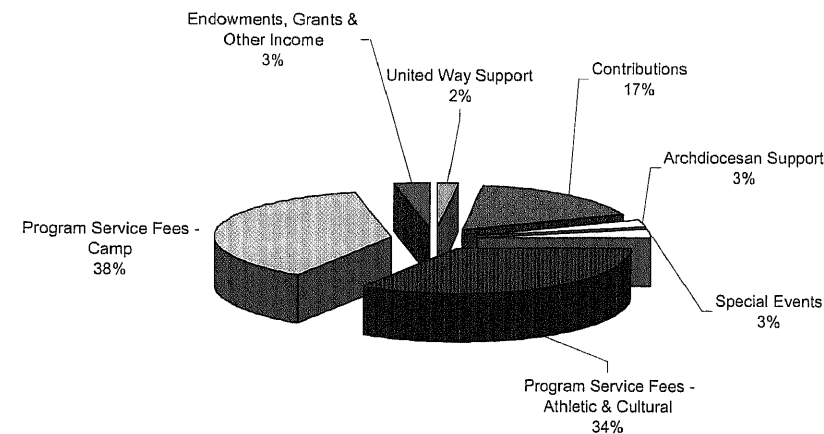

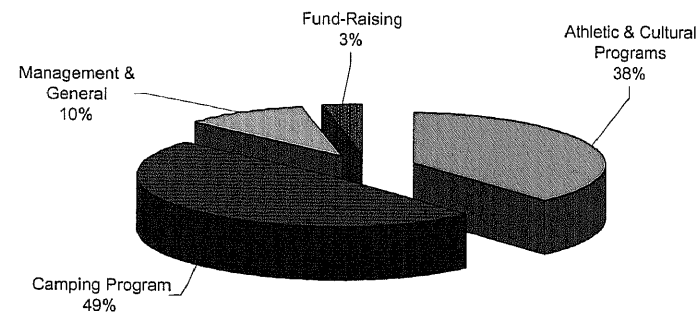
