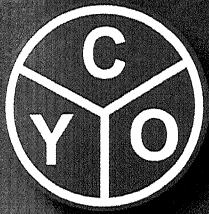

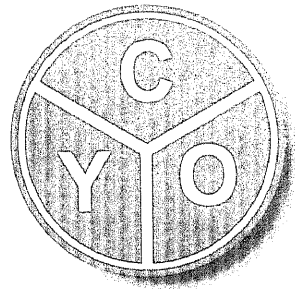

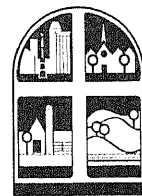

If you have participated in CYO programs in your youth or you currently have children participating in CYO programs you already know about the CYO experience. Through the years that experience has changed and CYO has evolved into an organization that serves nearly 20,000 boys and girls each year within our Catholic schools and parishes. However, one aspect of the CYO experience that has not changed is the fact that there is truly something for everyone to enjoy.

If athletics is your thing, the CYO offers 14 different sports for boys and girls to choose from. And, you don't have to be great athlete to participate as most CYO athletic activities are divided into separate leagues so that players can be grouped together based on skill level. No player is ever cut from a CYO team as the majority of schools and parishes have multiple teams in each CYO league. There is a team for every boy and girl who wants to participate.

If your interests lie in the area of cultural activities, the CYO sponsors one of the largest music contests in central Indiana with 900 students competing in piano, vocal and instrumental divisions. The CYO offers a unique competitive chess league where teams consisting of four players each compete together in a program that features academic competition among the schools. Boys and girls in grades one through eight participate in this program that has all the ingredients of science, sport and art rolled into one. And, for our young scientists, the CYO conducts a large science fair in which students from throughout the Archdiocese compete. Last year the top 135 students in

grades seven and eight selected from the thousands of students who developed science projects for their school science fairs participated in the CYO science fair.

For those who love the outdoors, CYO Camp Rancho Framasa has been offering an inclusive camping experience for the youth of the Indianapolis Archdiocese and beyond for the past 60 years. Camp Rancho Framasa is now a year round facility specializing in summer camp, leadership, outdoor education and retreat programming through the School Year. This past year alone, approximately 8,000 boys and girls spent quality time at CYO Camp Rancho Framasa.

And, for adults wishing to participate in the CYO experience, there are countless opportunities to volunteer at your parish with various CYO programs. The CYO recognizes the outstanding efforts of longtime volunteers through the presentation of the Monsignor Busald Award and the St. John Bosco Medal.

As I approach my 30th year with the Catholic Youth Organization, I continue to marvel at the greatness of youth and I am more committed than ever to faith based programs to help them along their journey of life. The CYO experience is for everyone and CYO programs can be used to show that all Catholic schools can excel in every way and teach values and build community at the same time.

I invite you to read through this CYO Annual Report for 2006-2007 and see for yourself that the CYO experience has something for everyone. Thank you for your continued support of the Catholic Youth Organization. May God bless you always.

A Brief History of *The Catholic Youth Organization*

The Catholic Youth Organization was established in 1939 by Bishop Joseph E. Ritter to assist parents in providing quality educational programs for children as well as to supplement the education provided by the Catholic schools.

The first official activity sponsored by the CYO was a city-wide spring dance in the Cathedral High School gymnasium with about 1,000 youth in attendance, representing every parish in the city. The first athletic leagues organized were baseball and tennis with steps taken in the early days of the CYO to organize other contests and competitions.

Since this humble beginning, the CYO has grown into one of the largest youth serving agencies in Central Indiana serving **20,000 young people** each year. In partnership with the Catholic schools, the CYO continues

to sponsor programs which serve to provide opportunities for youth to develop strong moral character, self worth and a community service orientation through activities of a social, educational, recreational, and athletic nature.

The CYO is the sole provider of extracurricular activities for the Catholic schools in the Indianapolis

metropolitan area. As such, it is the desire of the CYO to allow children the opportunity to experience real life situations that reinforce attitudes and values taught in school. In addition to providing athletic competition in 14 different sports for boys and girls in grades four through 12, the CYO also sponsors a science fair, music contest, honors music recital and a chess league.

In 1947, the CYO opened a summer residential camp in Brown County, Indiana on land given to the CYO by Mr. and Mrs. Bert Dingley the previous year.

Over time, Camp Rancho Framasa has grown into a facility offering year-round camping opportunities and an inclusive outdoor education program. The camp has recently undergone an extensive redevelopment plan including the construction of a dining hall/outdoor program center, three new cabins, the remodeling of all existing cabins and the refurbishing of the camp swimming pool. The facility has been improved to meet the needs of campers well into the 21st century.

The Catholic Youth Organization has been evolving for many years to what it is today. The CYO continues to be committed to providing a ministry of information that helps bring youth to their full human potential.

To each and every CYO volunteer, we say **Thank You!** May God bless your efforts always.

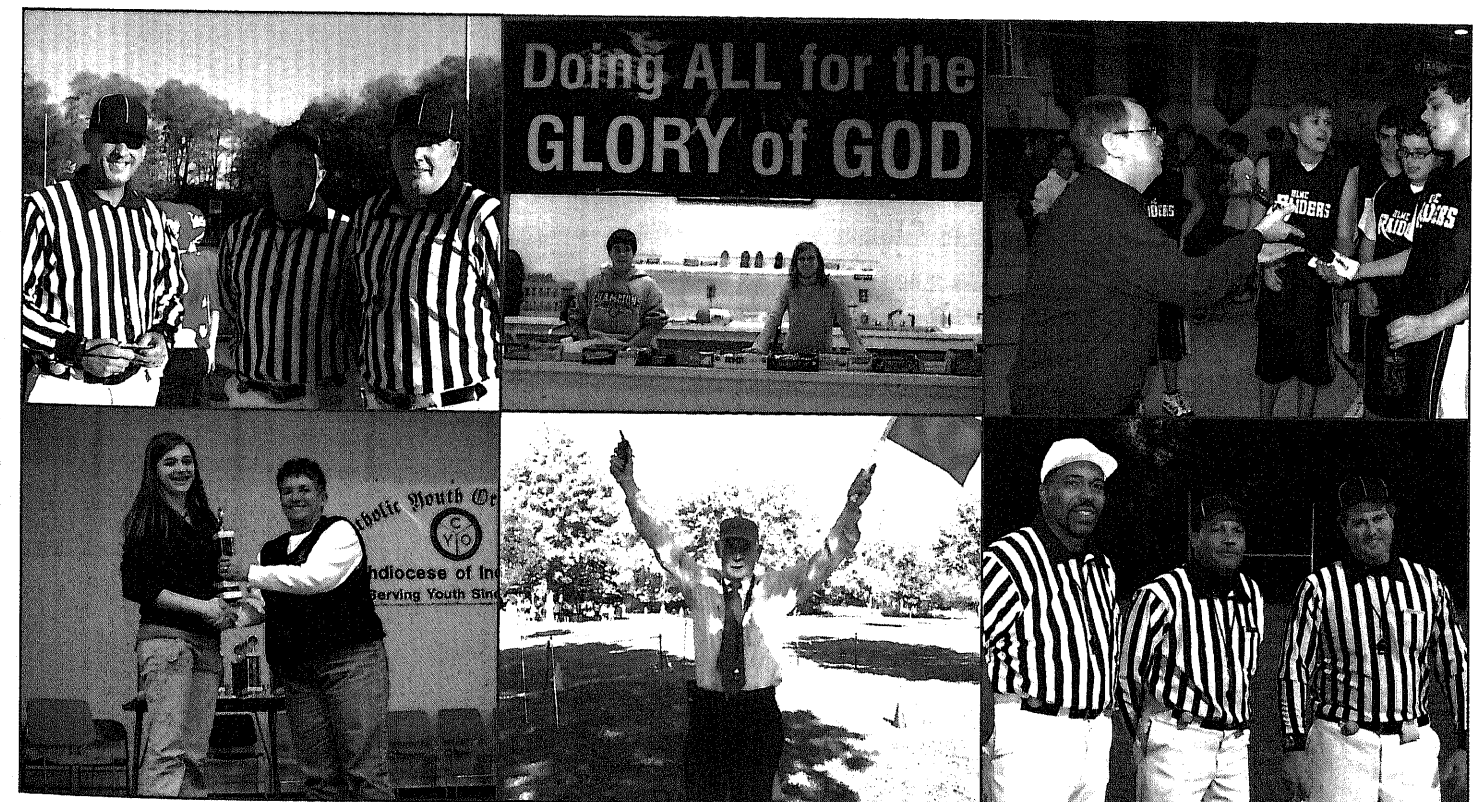
Officials

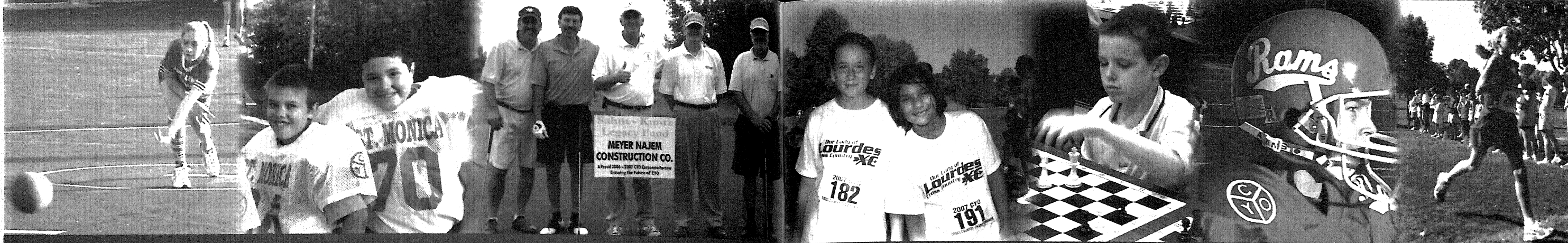

The CYO is fortunate to have some of the finest sports officials in the area involved with our program. At the same time, the organization believes in the positive development of young officials to carry on into the future.

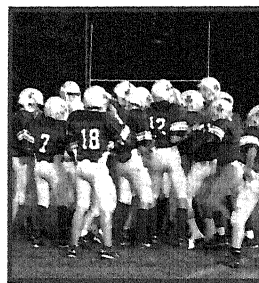
Each year almost **1,500 men and women** sign on to officiate CYO athletic contests and we thank them for their great service to youth. They are truly making a difference.

2006-2007 FALL PROGRAM SUMMARY



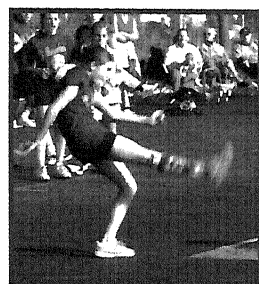
Football

For the 2006 CYO football season, the new tradition of a postseason tournament for all leagues, introduced in 2005, continued. To accommodate the tournament format each league was divided in half based on school size. The football leagues were as follows: 3rd grade A and AA, 34 A and AA, 4th grade A and AA, 5th grade, 56 A and AA and Cadet A and AA.

51 teams and 905 players participated in the 34 football league. 43 teams and 813 players participated in the 56 football league. 30 teams and 633 players participated in the Cadet football league.

2,351 total boys played CYO football on 124 parish teams. In 2005 2,329 boys played on 116 parish teams.

The CYO football championship games were played at Roncalli High School Stadium. During championship week 22 semi-final games and 11 championship games were played.



Fall Kickball

151 teams participated in five different leagues in grades four through eight. By comparison, 163 parish teams participated in the fall of 2005.

Competition was conducted in 4th grade, 56B, 56 A, Cadet B and Cadet A leagues. There were no C league teams this season.

With almost 2,000 girls participating in the CYO Fall Kickball Program, the sport continues to be one of the most popular and traditional activities on the CYO calendar.



Girls High School Volleyball

The 10th season for the Girls High School Volleyball Program was successful and enjoyable for the 220 girls that participated.

21 teams were entered into the program this Fall with games being played on Sunday afternoons.

The postseason tournament was played at the CYO Center Gymnasium on October 1, 2006.



Cross Country

17 teams participated in the ninth season of CYO Cross Country.

The program is offered to boys and girls in grades five through eight with over 500 youth participating.

The season consisted of four regular season meets and a city-wide championship meet, held again at Southeastway Park.



Chess

This was the ninth season for the CYO Chess Program for the Catholic schools.

This year 6 parishes entered 33 teams into the program with 132 youth participating. Last year 8 parishes entered 34 teams into the program.

Competition was divided into these separate age groups: 3rd Grade and Under, 6th Grade and Under, and 8th Grade and Under.

The league featured academic competition among schools and was based on team play with each team consisting of four players.

The program featured five weeks of competition and a postseason tournament held at the CYO Center Gymnasium.



Golf Outing

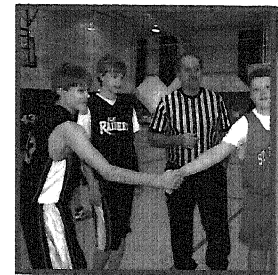
The 13th Annual CYO Golf Outing was held Thursday, September 14, 2006 at the Links Golf Club in New Palestine.

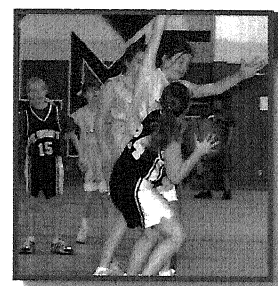
Boys Basketball

455 basketball teams were entered into the 2006-2007 Boys Basketball Program up from 452 teams in 2005-2006.

Over 3,700 boys and 900 coaches participated in the program.

Competition was held in 4th grade, 56 C, 56 B, 56 A, Cadet C, Cadet B, Cadet A, Freshmen – Sophomore, Junior – Senior and Girls High School leagues.

The Grade School Archdiocesan Championship game was played at Seecina Memorial High School on February 18, 2007.

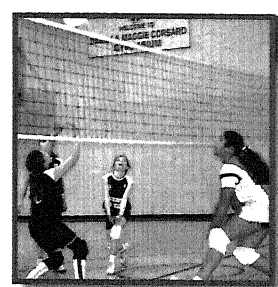


Girls Basketball

The CYO Girls Basketball Program continued to be strong in 2006 with 225 teams entered into the program. In 2005, 227 teams participated.

Competition was conducted in 4th Grade, 56 C, 56 B, 56 A, Cadet C, Cadet B, and Cadet A leagues.

Over 2000 girls participated in the CYO Girls Program.

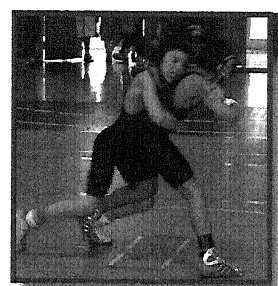


Girls Volleyball

Over 2,800 girls participated in the program.



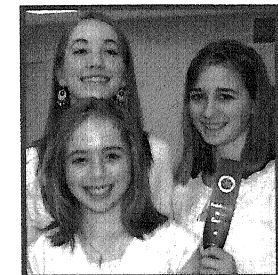
Wrestling

The Boys Wrestling Program continued to be steady with 15 teams entered in the 2007 season. 17 teams participated in 2006.

365 boys participated in the 2007 Wrestling Program.

Competition was held in 18 different weight classes beginning with 65 pounds and continuing up to 275 pounds.

The season – ending city tournament was hosted by Cardinal Ritter High School where 18 individual weight class winners were determined.



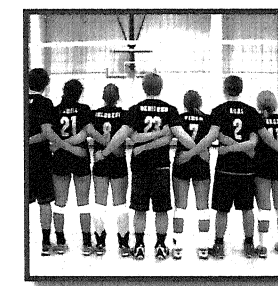
Music Contest

The 49th Annual CYO Archdiocesan Music Contest was held at Bishop Chatard High School for the 33rd consecutive year. Almost 900 students from throughout the Archdiocese participated in this one day event.

The CYO Music Contest is the only competition in the area other than the Indiana State Music Association Contest. Many students were entered into the contest through private music teachers and public schools with 25% of the students coming from outside the Catholic school system.

Competition was held in piano, vocal and instrumental divisions.

The most outstanding participants from the contest participated in an honors music recital at Cathedral High School one week after the contest.

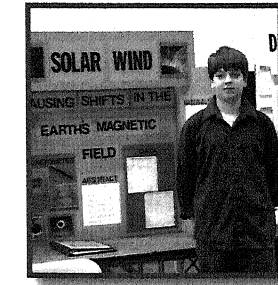


Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament

13 high school co-ed volleyball teams were entered into the 2007 Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament.

Over 120 high school boys and girls participated in the tournament held at the St. Roch Gymnasium.

This double-elimination tournament featured rally scoring and free substitution to keep the event fast paced and enjoyable.



Science Fair

17 schools and 120 students from throughout the Indianapolis Archdiocese participated in the 2007 CYO Science Fair held at the CYO Center Gymnasium.

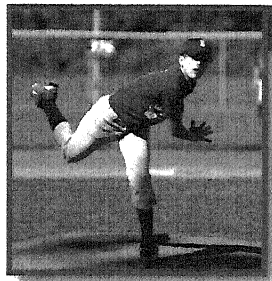
Participants in the science fair were winners from the many school science fairs held in schools in the Archdiocese.

Baseball

33 baseball teams were entered into the 2007 CYO baseball program and over 500 boys participated.

Of the 33 teams entered, 8 were 7th grade teams entered into a 7th grade league.

The 7th grade championship game was played at Msgr. Downey Field and the cadet championship game was played at Bishop Chatard High School.



Spring Kickball

53 teams participated in the 2007 Spring kickball program.

Fewer teams participate in the Spring kickball program compared to the Fall Program due to the increased number of activities in the Spring for the girls.

Over 650 girls played kickball in the 2007 CYO Spring Kickball Program.

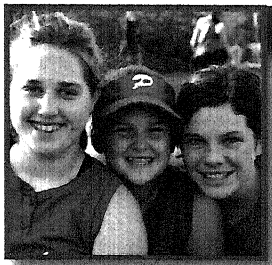


Soccer

62 teams were entered into the 2007 CYO Soccer Program. Thirty Cadet level teams and 32 56 level teams.

The soccer league championship games were played at the St. Matthew Soccer Field.

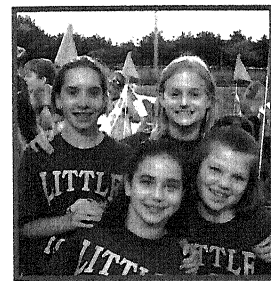


Softball

The girls softball program had 12 teams participate in 2007, up from 11 teams in 2006. This was the fifth season for CYO softball and 150 girls participated.

It is anticipated that the CYO Softball Program will grow slightly in the coming years. Conflicts with other softball leagues and a shortage of fields and umpires could prevent this program from growing.



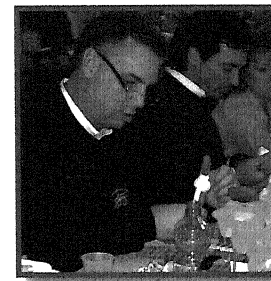
Track

Bingo

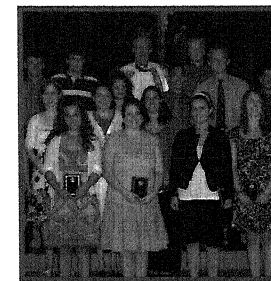

Rancho Round Up

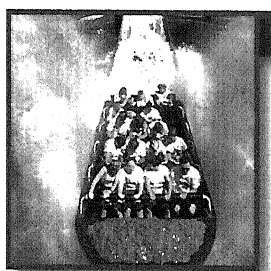
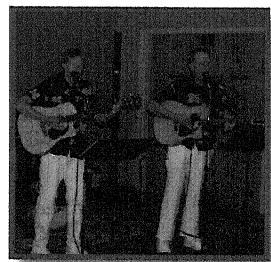

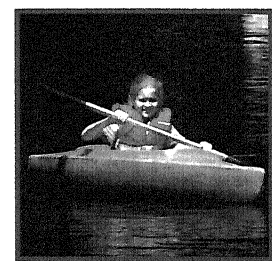
Kings Island Day

Camp Rancho Framasa

The 2007 CYO summer Camp program had over 2,300 campers participate in the nine week camping season.

The Summer camping season began June 3, 2007 and concluded August 5, 2007.

CYO camp's inclusion program provides extra support for campers with special needs. The inclusion program was fortunate to receive over \$15,000 in grant monies to support its important ministry. This summer 32 campers received one on one support from a counselor and 133 campers received floater support. Children attending the camp's inclusion program had medical, emotional, and or physical disability.

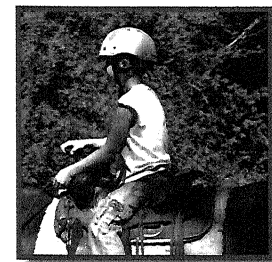
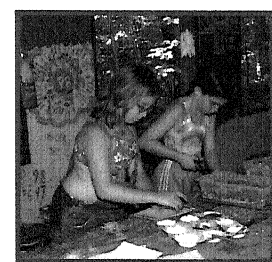
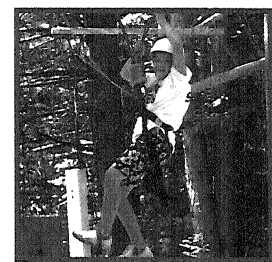
Campers were able to choose from five different camping experiences including: Traditional Camp, Sassafras Camp, Adventure Camp, Traditional Camp for Teens and Junior Counselor Program.

Summer camp activities include: Swimming, Archery, Canoeing, Games, Campfires, Sports, Horseback Riding, Nature, Handicrafts, Hiking, Drama, Scripture, Climbing Towers, Ranchfest, Camp-out, Cook-out, Mass, Gold Rush, High Rope Challenge and Low Rope Challenge.

In 2007 CYO camp collaborated with Fatima Retreat House to offer day camp for one week during the summer. The Grasshopper Day Camp was held at Fatima Retreat House and 87 campers participated. There were 40 half day campers and 47 full day campers. The full day campers also visited CYO Camp Rancho Framasa for an entire day and were treated to many camp programs, a meal and an afternoon swim.

The CYO Camp Outdoor Education program is based on Catholic values taught and modeled at Catholic Schools. This value based ministry is an integrated part of each student's outdoor learning experience. In 2007, 115 school groups participated in CYO Camp Rancho Framasa's Outdoor Education Program.

In effect this partnership has added seventeen certified athletic trainers and sixteen sports medicine physicians to the staff of the CYO.

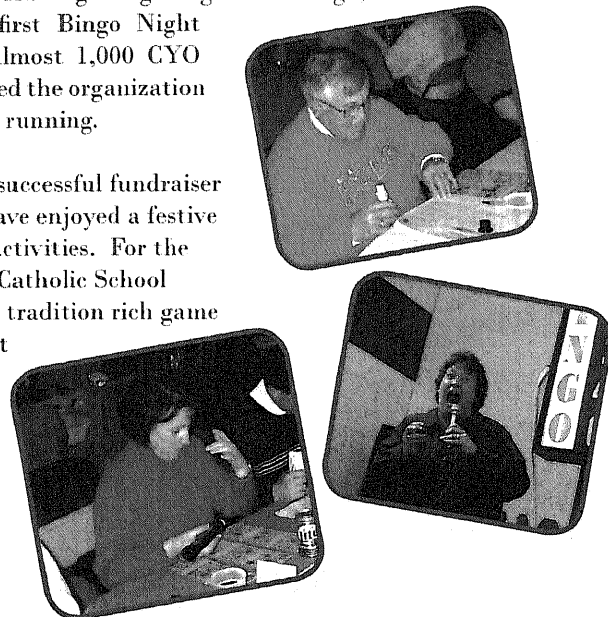
CYO Bingo

RANCHO Round Up

In 1946 Mr. and Mrs. Bert Dingley gave The Catholic Youth Organization 280 acres of land in scenic Brown County, Indiana for the purpose of establishing a Catholic camping facility for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The camp was named Rancho Framasa after the Dingley's three daughters, Frances, Martha and Samuella. The first year of organized camping was in 1947. The number of boys and girls attending camp that year was 275, and in 1950 over 400. Currently 2,500 children attend Camp Rancho Framasa each summer.

Over the years since 1946, CYO Camp Rancho Framasa has evolved and in addition to the summer camping program the facility now offers year-round programs which includes outdoor education for students K-8th grades, leadership programs for students 7-12th grades and retreat programs for various age groups.

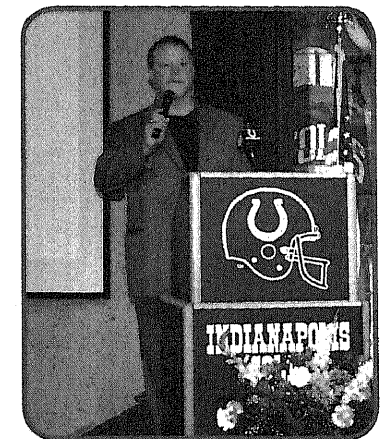
Since 1993, the facility at Camp Rancho Framasa has been undergoing a complete face lift with the construction of an outdoor program center complete with a new dining hall and meeting rooms, at a cost of \$1,600,000 as the centerpiece of the facility. Three beautiful new cabins have been built and all existing cabins have been renovated. The camp swimming pool has also recently been renovated. The grand total of money spent on camp upgrades, renovations and new camp buildings since 1993 is \$3,276,000. So, as you can see, the CYO continues to be committed to the values and traditions of a Catholic camping experience within the framework of the Catholic Church and schools of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The 60th anniversary of Catholic camping at the CYO is truly worth celebrating.
