OUR HISTORY...

- CYO was established in 1939, CYO Camp opened in 1946.
- For over 80 years, CYO has served close to 2 MILLION young people.
- Each year over 20,000 youths participate in CYO activities.
- Over 6,000 adult volunteers are involved.
- 8 CYO sports offered for both girls and boys.
- Other activities = Music Competitions, Chess Club & Science Fair.
- All activities are Christ-centered and faith formation driven.

OUR CHALLENGES...

- Because of the Pandemic, we were not able to have spring sports or camp activities, and we could not have June or July summer camp.
- THIS RESULTED IN A LOSS OF \$800,000 IN REVENUE SINCE MARCH!!
- In recent years CYO has lost over \$150,000 annually in agency funding because we are a faith-based, mission-driven agency.

OUR DILEMMA...

- Each year we subsidize \$120,000 to help families who struggle to pay sports registration fees and camp fees.
- Each year we subsidize \$70,000 to our Inclusion Program, which enables 150 special needs students to attend CYO summer camp.
- <u>WITHOUT YOUR HELP</u>, given COVID losses and lost agency funding, we will be forced to end our assistance to families in need!!
